NOTES ON INDIVIDUAL COURSES

- 1 **API420 with Robert Putnam:** Offered two "Available Online" required packets and one "Available Online" optional packet for potential savings of \$96.57 and \$26.64, respectively.
- 2 **HCP382 with John Ruggie:** Offered one "Available Online" packet for a potential savings of \$33.30.
- 3 **HUT100 with William Apgar:** Offered four "Available Online" packets for a potential savings of \$120.62.
- 4 **HUT201 with Luberoff & Altshuler:** Offered one "Available Online" packet for a potential savings of \$16.65.
- 5 **ISP100 with Stephen Walt:** Offered one "Available Online" packet for a potential savings of \$4 **8.47**
- 6 **ISP210 with Ashton Carter:** Offered three "Available Online" packets for a potential savings of \$96.57.
- 7 **PAL110 with David King:** There was one required text for all and a choice of one of two. Student had to attend class and choose book to purchase.
