NOTES CONCERNING THIS REPORT:

This information only includes the charges for course materials available through the CMO and/or materials available through the Harvard Coop.

Students may have had to purchase materials in jointly listed courses at other CMO's or at the Coop under a non-KSG course code.

This report is a record of what a student would have paid for course materials during the Spring 2004 semester if that student chose to purchase all course materials for a course.

This report is not a "price list" of what a student will pay for a particular course during the Spring 2005 semester,

but it may provide a student reasonable information with which to predict course costs.

NOTES ON INDIVIDUAL COURSES

- ISP205 with Ashton Carter:** Offered five "Available Online" packets for a potential savings of \$233.10.
- ISP221 with Samantha Power:** Offered six "Available Online" packets for a potential savings of \$135.05.
- ISP228 with Jacqueline Bhabha:** Offered four "Available Online" packets for a potential savings of \$60.68
- PAL109 with Hannah Riley:** There was an online testing testing for MLQ. No packet was associated with the testing. Students were billed \$20.00 each for the service.
Cost for online testing service was treated as a classroom handout charge for the purposes of this chart.
- PED118 with Calestous Juma:** Offered one "Available Online" packet for a potential savings of \$49.21.
- PED502 with Joseph Kalt:** Offered two "Available Online" packets for a potential savings of \$58.09
- STM101C with Steve Kelman:** Students choose one required text from three with price range of \$18.95 to \$46.00. Highest priced book added to chart above.
- STM101D with Elaine Kamarck:** Students choose one required text from three with price range of \$16.00 to \$34.95. Highest priced book added to chart above.

HARVARD COOP BOOKS

Only new text book prices are listed; used copies, when available, represent a 25% savings for the student.

CLASSROOM HANDOUTS

Classroom handouts are treated as "required" materials and are included in the "O. Req'd Total" column in addition to "H. Handouts".

LEGEND TO COLUMN HEADINGS

A. Spring 2004 Course: The column lists all of the courses that offered reading materials through the CMO and/or the Harvard Coop during the Spring 2004 semester.

B. Section Letter: Not all sections with the same course code share the same materials (e.g., STM101A compared to sections B, C and D)

C. Instructor Name: If the same instructor is teaching the same course for Spring 2005, it is possible that the cost of the materials will remain approximately the same.

D. Req'd Packets: The total cost of required reading packets (i.e., materials the instructor expects you to have read for the course).

E. #: The number of required course packets distributed.

F. Opt'l Packets: The total cost of non-required (the Harvard Coop uses the term "recommended").

G. #: The number of optional packets.

H. Handouts. The amount billed to students at the end of the semester for classroom handouts.

I. Total Cost: The total cost of both required and optional materials plus classroom handouts.

HARVARD COOP (The Harvard Cooperative Society)

J. Req'd Books: The total cost of required reading text books (i.e., materials the instructor expects you to have read for the course).

K. #: The number of required text books distributed.

L. Opt'l Books: The total cost of non-required text books (the Harvard Coop uses the term "recommended").

M. #: The number of optional text books.

N. Total Cost: The total cost of both required and optional text books.

CMO & COOP TOTALS

O. Req'd Total: The total cost of required course packets, plus the cost of classroom handouts and required text books from the Coop.

P. Opt'l Total: The total cost of both non-required course packets and non-required text books from the Coop (the Harvard Coop uses the term "recommended").

Q. Total Cost: The total of both required and non-required materials distributed by the CMO and the Coop.
