Lynette Lithgow Summer Internship Application Form

In honor of the late Lynette Lithgow, a former Shorenstein Center fellow and BBC anchorwoman, the Shorenstein Center established a summer internship for Harvard Kennedy School students. The Lithgow Internship Fund provides an opportunity for students to gain practical experience within the field of journalism. A stipend of \$3,000 will be awarded to a Harvard Kennedy School student who has secured a summer internship position working for a news organization.

HKS students are responsible for obtaining employment, and the position should be full-time and last a minimum of eight weeks. The Lithgow Internship is intended to benefit students with non-paying or low-paying positions. HKS students must be returning to school in the fall to qualify.

How to apply: Please submit a current resume and a one-page proposal. Include a description of the news organization and the focus of your internship. Please explain how the internship you have secured will complement your education and reinforce your career goals.
