Proposal: A 3-page description of the proposed project including specific information demonstrating how the applicant's work contributes to "sustainability science," the emerging field of use-inspired research encompassing studies of the interactions between human and environmental systems as well as the sustainability challenges relating to agriculture/land use/food, biodiversity, cities, energy and materials, health and water. Include a budget for up to \$40,000 in direct costs.
