[American Near East Refugee Aid \(ANERA\)](#)

Mission: Refugees, poverty, strife in the Holy Land; we provide emergency relief and self-help projects for children/families in the West Bank, Gaza Strip, Lebanon.

Comments: Established 30 years ago, ANERA is principally concerned with the long-term development needs of Palestinians and Lebanese, but also provides some project support in Jordan and Israel. The organization assists grassroots organizations to provide their communities with crucial health and welfare services in addition to increasing employment and educational opportunities. Another focus is to support local institutions working to improve the status and opportunities for deprived groups. In addition, ANERA helps provide the basic necessities of life to people adversely affected by war and conflict. Through these efforts and through increasing American understanding of the region, ANERA promotes peace.

Mission: Provides more than one million refugees and displaced persons with medical care, self-help training and related services in eight countries worldwide.

Comments: ARC was formed in 1978 by a group of concerned business and community leaders whose mission was to help resettle refugees fleeing their homelands as a result of the Indo-Chinese conflict. In 1979, while ARC was providing resettlement assistance domestically, the organization began sending teams of medical and related specialists to refugee sites in Thailand to provide primary health care and training for Hmong refugees. This effort quickly expanded to respond to the massive implosion of Cambodian refugees shortly after ARC's arrival. ARC also responded to the refugee outflows of Mozambique and Ethiopia in the early 1980s.

AMERI-CARES

Mission: AmeriCares supports long-term health programs and provides immediate response to medical needs wherever and whenever they exist around the world for all people-irrespective of race, color, creed or political persuasion. Corporate donations of medicines, medical supplies and other relief materials are delivered safely to indigenous health and welfare professionals in many areas of the United States and many other countries. With a 1.5% overhead, AmeriCares is the first to bring help and hope when disaster and famine bring homelessness and hunger.

Comments: Since its infancy in 1982, AmeriCares has delivered over one-half billion dollars worth of life-saving emergency relief. AmeriCares provided relief to millions at risk of starvation in Africa, to the innocent victims of war in Bosnia and Croatia, to Americans recovering from Hurricane Andrew, the Midwest floods, and the Los Angeles earthquakes, and to Russians struggling through a difficult transition to freedom. With only 1.07% of expenses going to fund raising and administration, AmeriCares is at the top of America's most efficient charities.

CATHOLIC RELIEF SERVICES –USCC

Mission: Since 1943, a leader in international relief and development, helping needy people in 80 countries; alleviating suffering, supporting self-help programs, restoring and preserving human dignity.

CARE INTERNATIONAL

Comments: CARE is one of the world's largest private international relief and development organizations. CARE has operations in 50 countries around the world. Founded in 1945 to send emergency CARE Packages of food, clothing and medicine to Europe and Asia after World War II, CARE soon broadened its scope to help poor people around the world.

Comments: Established in 1936. CI activities during 1997 included scouting programs, day camps and group classes designed to help build self-esteem in the 14,000 participants; 146,424 sponsored children attended celebrations for holidays and other special occasions; self-help classes to teach parents the value of keeping their children in school, regular medical and dental checkups and immunizations, and

making hygiene and sanitation a priority in their home; and a health fair to teach interested boys and girls basic health information and proper sanitation.

CHURCH WORLD SERVICE/CROP

Mission: Helps end hunger near and far. Assists refugees and disaster survivors. Provides tools of hope for grassroots development: food, water, education, healthcare, reforestation and self-reliance.

Comments: Church World Service/CROP has brought help and hope to the hungry, the sick the homeless, and the oppressed for nearly 50 years. Church World Service partners with 34 Protestant and Orthodox denominations around the world to meet basic human needs with economic and social development programs, disaster and emergency relief and services to refugees and immigrants. With churches and organizations in more than 70 countries sharing the struggle to help people move beyond poverty and powerless, the organization works with local agencies to address local initiatives.

Food production; Primary health care; Literacy; Job training.

DOCTORS WITHOUT BORDERS

Comments: Doctors Without Borders/Médecins Sans Frontières (MSF) is the world's largest independent international medical relief agency aiding victims of armed conflict, epidemics, and natural and man-made disasters, and others who lack health care due to geographic remoteness or ethnic marginalization. Annually, more than 2,000 volunteers representing 45 nationalities work in over 80 countries in front-line hospitals, refugee camps, disaster sites, towns, and villages. Doctors Without Borders teams provide primary health care, perform surgery, vaccinate children, rehabilitate hospitals, operate emergency nutrition and sanitation programs, and train local medical staff.

INTERNATIONAL RESCUE COMMITTEE

Mission: Founded in 1933, the International Rescue Committee is the leading non-profit, nonsectarian voluntary organization providing relief, protection, and resettlement services for refugees and victims of oppression or violent conflict.

Comments: IRC was established at the request of Albert Einstein in 1933 to assist anti-Nazi opponents of Hitler. It is the nation's largest private nonsectarian voluntary agency assisting refugees worldwide. IRC helps victims of racial, religious, ethnic and political persecution, and people uprooted by war and violence. IRC is particularly recognized for its ability to provide immediate lifesaving relief in emergencies. Money magazine, in its 1994 survey of charitable organizations, named IRC as "the most efficient relief and development charity." IRC has created a special program that provides psychological and medical treatment for Bosnian and Croatian war-injured children, rape victims and those emotionally devastated from seeing loved ones killed in the war. With 65 years of experience helping those in needs, IRC was recognized for its effectiveness in 1997 with the Conrad N. Hilton Humanitarian Prize.
